

GMO







Regulation (EC) no. 1829/2003 requires GMOs to be labelled.

Foodstuffs, food ingredients and feedstuffs are exempt from labelling, provided that the presence of GMOs or derivatives is less than **0.9%**, and that in the event of presence, the operator is able to justify that it is fortuitous (accidental and unforeseeable) or technically unavoidable (cross-pollination in the field, for example). If one of these two conditions is not met, the product must be labelled GMO. This does not apply to products such as milk, meat or eggs from animals fed with GMOs.
